

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Windows: PC 300 MHz Pentium or faster, Windows 95/98/2000/ME/XP, 32 MB RAM, 20 MB free hard disk space, 12x CD-ROM, display 640x480, 16-bit color, QuickTime 4 for Windows or higher, soundcard, videocard

Macintosh: PowerPC 200 MHz or faster, MacOS 8.5.1-9.2/OS-X Classic, 32 MB RAM, 20 MB free hard disk space, 12x CD-ROM, display 640x480, 16-bit color, QuickTime 4 or higher

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Install RHEM only on the condition that you, the customer, accept the terms of the License Agreement (Read_Me_file on the RHEM_CD). Make sure you have installed QuickTime 4 or higher (free download: www.apple.com/quicktime/).

Windows:

Insert the RHEM CD into your CD-ROM drive.

With Installer 1.version...

Double-click the Installer icon on the CD. Follow the on-screen instructions.

With Installer 2.version...

Click on the Start menu and select Run. Type D:/Installer.exe (where D: corresponds to the letter of your CD drive) and click OK. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Or Manually...

Copy the folder RhemE (Drag and Drop) on to your hard drive.

Macintosh:

Insert RHEM_CD into your CD-ROM drive.

With Installer...

Double-click the Installer icon on the CD. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Or Manually...

Copy the folder RhemE (Drag and Drop) on to your hard drive.

MONITOR SETTINGS

Windows 95/98/2000/ME:

To change the monitor settings, point the mouse pointer (arrow) to an open, empty part of the screen and RIGHT click.

Select Properties, then select Settings.

Under Color Palette choose High Color [Thousands of Colors (16 bit)]

Under Resolution Palette choose 640x480, then select OK.

If your monitor is set to a resolution of 640x480 but you have hooked up several monitors at the same time, you may be asked to change the resolution. In that case, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup and again clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.

If it is not possible to set the resolution to 640x480, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup and again clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.

Windows XP:

To change the monitor settings, point the mouse pointer (arrow) to an open, empty part of the screen and RIGHT click.

Select Properties, then select Settings.

Under Color Palette choose High Color [Thousands of Colors (16 bit)], then select OK.

Select the RHEM icon (RHEM.exe) in the folder RhemE on your hard drive by RIGHT clicking.

Select Properties, then select Compatible.

Choose the option to run at 640x480.

When you launch the game, the window changes automatically.

If your monitor is set to a resolution of 640x480 but you have hooked up several monitors at the same time, it may happen that you will be asked to change the resolution. In that case, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup and again clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.

If it is not possible to set the resolution to 640x480, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup and again clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.

Macintosh:

To change the monitor settings, open the Monitor Control Panel.

This item can be found in the Apple Menu under the Control Panels menu item. Set your monitor to Thousands of Colors (16-bit) and 640x480.

If your monitor is set to a resolution of 640x480 but you have hooked up several monitors at the same time, it may happen that you will be asked to change the resolution. In that case, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup and again clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.

If it is not possible to set the resolution to 640x480, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup and again clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.

STARTING RHEM

Insert the RHEM CD into your CD-ROM drive. Make sure your monitor is set to 640x480 and Thousands of Colors (16-bit). Locate the RhemE folder on your

hard disk, double-click on it to open it and double-click the RHEM icon (Rhem.exe) in the RhemE folder on your hard drive. To begin a new game, click NEW GAME. To restore a saved game, click LOAD GAME.

REMOVING RHEM

Drag the RhemE folder on your hard drive into the trash and empty the trash.

PLAYING RHEM

When you start the game, the opening movie will run and you will be transported to the land of RHEM via rail car. The car has been commandeered and you must sit tight in one spot, momentarily unable to leave. As the car slowly begins to roam about RHEM, you discover the mysteries of this place little by little. You soon learn that the only possibility of returning home is a letter, consisting of four hidden fragments, which you must not only find but also put together.


- 👉 move forward / action
- 👈 no action
- 👉👈 use / pick up object
- 👉👉 move forward + left / right
- 👈👉 turn left / right 90°
- 👈👉 turn left / right 180°
- 👉👉 look up / look down
- 👉 move backwards

The handcursor will provide direct feedback on where you can go and what you can do. Simply click the mouse to move, turn, move levers, open doors etc. If you want to examine, use, or pick up an object, click on it, or click and drag it.

At the bottom of the screen is a "hidden" inventory of the objects that you are carrying. To access the Menu (Save Game, Load Game, Quit Game) press the spacebar or CTRL+M (Win) / CMD+M (Mac).

The environment consists of individual pictures covering a 360-degree view. In principle, each standpoint has four views.

As you explore the world of RHEM you will uncover its secrets. This is a rich and complex place with its own logic and rules, but where every element and environment has been created with a purpose. Sometimes you may not be able to enter the next phase until you have found certain items, but there are no dead-ends. You may reach a wall, but there is always a way around it. Pay attention to details, collection information, and use logic! Explore the land of RHEM.

- Do not delete/move folder or files in RhemE.

- Put the RHEM CD into the CD-drive while starting the game.

- If your monitor is set to a resolution of 604x480 but you have hooked up several monitors at the same time, it may happen that you will be asked to change the resolution. In that case, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.

Macintosh:

- Make sure you have installed QuickTime 4 or higher.
- Do not name a hard drive RHEM_CD.
- Make sure you have turned off virtual memory and file sharing.
- Turn off any unnecessary extensions.
- RHEM is designed to use 32 MB RAM.
- Make sure your monitor is set to Thousands of Colors (16 bit) and 640x480.
- Check the volume level, the Sound Control Panel and the speaker and/or headphone connections.
- Do not save a game with the name Rhem, Rhem.pct or any other used names.
- Do not delete/move folder or files in RhemE.
- Put the RHEM_CD into the CD-drive while starting the game.
- If your monitor is set to a resolution of 604x480 but you have hooked up several monitors at the same time, it may happen that you will be asked to change the resolution. In that case, start the game by clicking Start application with inappropriate monitor setup.




